## Kyoto City Bus / Subway Basic info

### Riding the Kyoto City Bus

Please board from the rear

**Pay When You Get Off**  
Pay when you are disembarking. The fare for Nonflat Fare Routes and Flat Fare Routes is different.

### When you see your stop coming push the button.

You can see the next bus stop on the display in front of the bus, or you can hear the announcement. When you hear or see that your stop is next push the button.

### Convenient and Reasonable Card

**A** Kyoto City Subway, Kyoto City Bus, Kyoto Bus, Keihan Bus One-Day (Two-Day) Pass  
One-day pass:900yen Two-day pass:1,700yen (children half-price)  
Unlimited rides on all Kyoto City Bus routes, all Kyoto City subway lines, Kyoto Bus (excluding certain routes), and Keihan Bus (excluding certain routes).

**B** Kyoto City Bus & Kyoto Bus One-Day Pass  
For unlimited travel within the Flat-Fare Zone of Kyoto City Bus & Kyoto Bus (600yen) (Children - Half-price)  
Unlimited rides for one day to stop within the Kyoto City Bus / Kyoto Bus flat rate zone. Rides to stops outside the flat rate zone are subject to additional fare charges.

**C** Kyoto City Subway One-Day Pass  
Unlimited rides on all Kyoto City subways:600 yen (children half-price)  
This pass allows unlimited rides on all Kyoto City subways for one day.

### Payment Types of Bus Boarding Disembarking

**A** Subway, Bus One-Day (Two-Day) Pass  
**B** Bus One-Day Pass

**Flat Fare Routes**  
One day cards are valid for Flat Fare Routes.  
For Example 9 205 etc.  
Same procedure applies for Kyoto Bus.

**Non-flat Fare Routes**  
Extra fare will sometimes be required with this type of bus.  
Buses with black numbers on white fields are long-distance buses.  
For Example 8 etc.  
Some procedure applies for Kyoto Bus.

**The first time** you get-off simply put the card into the card slot. On the back of the card the date will be printed.  
**After the first time** simply show your card with the date to the driver.

Please insert the card once again into the machine.  
Note) Use of **B** Kyoto City Bus & Kyoto Bus One-Day Pass to stops outside the valid rate zone is subject to additional fare charges.

### Riding the subway

**A** Subway, Bus One-Day (Two-Day) Pass  
**C** Subway One-Day Pass

**When boarding or departing a train...**  
Pass the card through the card reader slot at the automated ticket gates before entering or exiting the subway.  
\*Make sure to take the card out of the other end of the reader.
